

ORDINANCE NO. 791

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA, TO AMEND SECTION 4-211 (A) AND SECTION 4-211 (E) FOR SNOW REMOVAL AND STREET MAINTENANCE; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; AND TO PROVIDE THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4-211(A) is hereby amended, as follows:

SECTION 4-211 (A):

It shall be unlawful to park or stand any vehicle on any street or alley in the Village at any time within 12 hours after a snowfall of ~~three inches or more~~ any amount of plowable snow has occurred within a 24-hour period, unless the snow has been removed within that time.

Section 2. Section 4-211(E) is hereby amended, as follows:

SECTION 4-211 (E):

A person designated by the Village Board shall order that any vehicle found unattended on any of the above designated streets during a snow emergency be "red-tagged" with a notice requiring the immediate removal of the vehicle. Any red-tagged vehicle which is not removed within 24 12 hours following being red-tagged will be towed to a place designated by the Village Board.

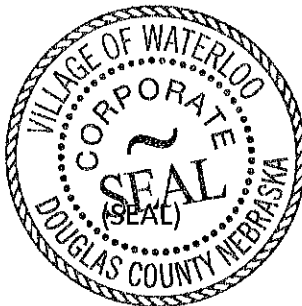
Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force fifteen (15) days from and after the date of its passage, as required by law.
