

Increase maximum number of FD members

ORDINANCE NO. 773

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 8-102 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA, TO CHANGE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT MEMBERS FROM FIFTY-TWO TO FIFTY-FIVE; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; AND; TO PROVIDE FOR THE PREPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE THE EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Waterloo Municipal Code book is amended as follows:

Section 8-102: MEMBERSHIP

A. The Fire Chief shall appoint no more than ~~52~~ 55 members for each Fire Department company subject to the review and approval of the Village Board. All vacancies shall be filled in this manner. Said members shall be considered to be employees of the Village for the purpose of providing them with workmen's compensation and other benefits. Each member shall be entitled to a term life insurance policy in the amount of at least \$10,000.00 dollars for death from any cause to age 65 and such policy shall, at the option of the individual firefighter, be convertible to a permanent form of life insurance at age 65; provided, the firemen covered are actively and faithfully performing the duties of their position. 
Section 2. Chapter 8, Article 1, Section 8-102 shall remain in full force and effect as hereby amended.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force fifteen (15) days from and after the date of its passage, as required by law.


