WHEREAS, the provisions of Chapter 3, Article 1, Water Department, and the provisions of Chapter 3, Article 3, Sewer Department, provide that the Village is entitled to a lien on the real estate for delinquent water and sewer use fees on the premises for which the same were used; and

WHEREAS, Ricky J. Kanne, who owns the property at 25018 Mason Street has become delinquent for water and sewer use fees to the extent of \$ 238.77; and

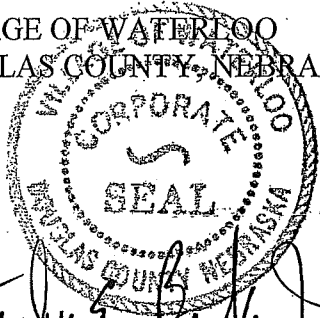
WHEREAS, Ricky J. Kanne is the owner of the following described real property, to wit: WEST SHORES LOT 133 BLK 0 IRREG.

WHEREAS, the Village Board has examined the account of Ricky J. Kanne and does approve the filing of the lien on such property for such delinquent water and sewer use fees.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE WATERLOO, DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, that the Clerk of the Municipality certify to the County Clerk of Douglas County, Nebraska, such delinquency; and that such delinquent water and sewer use fees shall be and hereby is declared a lien against said real property, to be collected as a special tax in the manner required by law.
