RESOLUTION NO. 02-28-12-02**

WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau has notified the Village of Waterloo (the "Village") that its population has exceeded eight hundred inhabitants; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Waterloo Board of Trustees has received petitions requiring the submission to the voters of the question of should the village form of government be retained; and,

WHEREAS, said petitions have been examined and have been found to contain the duly executed signatures of Village voters in excess of one-fourth, being in excess of one-hundred, of the registered voters of the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:


THAT, pursuant to Section 17-312 of the Revised Nebraska Statutes, the petitions, attached hereto, are hereby certified to have been duly acknowledged and contain the valid signatures of Village registered voters in excess of one-fourth, being in excess of one-hundred, of the registered voters of the Village; and.

FURTHER, THAT the following ballot question shall be submitted to the voters at the next regularly scheduled election, to wit: "SHALL THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA, HAVING A POPULATION IN EXCESS OF 800 INHABITANTS, RETAIN ITS VILLAGE FORM OF GOVERNMENT?"

FURTHER, THAT notice of said election and ballot question shall be published for at least thirty days prior to such regularly scheduled election.


