APPOINTMENT OF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of the Village of Waterloo that public nuisances, as defined within the Municipal Code, are abated in a timely manner; and


WHEREAS, Section 3-403 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Waterloo provides that the Village Board of Trustees may designate code enforcement officers, in addition to the Village Clerk, in order to initially enforce the public nuisance abatement provisions of the Municipal Code.

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, the Assistant Village Clerk, the Maintenance Supervisor and all Police Officers of the Village of Waterloo are hereby designated Code Enforcement Officers, pursuant to Section 3-403 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Waterloo, for the purpose of enforcing the public nuisance abatement provisions of the Village of Waterloo Municipal Code.
