

**VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 08-14-12-04**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE QUESTION OF INCREASING THE VILLAGE SALES TAX FROM ONE AND ONE-HALF PERCENT (1½%) TO TWO PERCENT (2%) TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 77-27,142 of the Nebraska Revised Statutes has been amended to allow any incorporated municipality to increase its local sales and use tax to a rate greater than one and one-half percent (1½%), but not to exceed two percent (2%), with the approval of the qualified electors of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, the proceeds from the rate in excess of one and one-half percent (1½%), must be used for public infrastructure projects; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village of Waterloo to increase the Village sales and use tax from the existing one and one-half percent (1½%) to two percent (2%) upon the same transactions within the Village on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose such tax; and

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Chairperson pro tempore and Board of Trustees of the Village of Waterloo, Nebraska, as follows:

**THAT**, the following question be submitted to the qualified electors of the Village of Waterloo, Nebraska at the statewide general election to be held on the 6th day of November, 2012, to wit:

**PROPOSITION**


“Shall the governing body of the Village of Waterloo, Nebraska, impose a sales and use tax of one-half percent (½%) in addition to the one and one-half percent (1½%) sales and use tax currently in effect, for a total sales and use tax of two percent (2%) upon the same transactions within the Village on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose such tax pursuant to the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967, as amended; which additional one-half percent (½%) sales and use tax shall be used for public infrastructure purposes which may include, but not be limited to, the construction or repair of street, water, storm protection or sewer facilities and systems.”

- FOR said additional sales and use tax
- AGAINST said additional sales and use tax

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be submitted to the Douglas County Election Commissioner by September 1, 2012, so that the question shall be presented to qualified electors at the General Election on November 6, 2012.
