

**VILLAGE OF WATERLOO
RESOLUTION NO. 08-23-16-01**

WHEREAS, the Village of Waterloo, Nebraska, (the "Village") is applying for federal assistance from the Recreational Trails Program for the purpose of assisting in the funding of Waterloo Trail, Phase 4 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project will begin at the east end of the existing trail where it intersects 2nd Street. From that location the existing ramp will be removed and the 2nd Street crossing relocated to the north to occur at Denton Drive. From the street crossing, the trail will follow the toe of the 2nd Street road bed slope to the south and then curve along the back end of the residential lots (between the houses and the open play area/basketball court) where it will then proceed east along the toe of the Blondo Street slope. There is an area preliminarily graded for the trail in this area. The trail will end with a cul-de-sac near the Blondo and River Road Intersection. The trail is about 2,850 feet long and will be 8 feet wide constructed of 6 inch thick concrete.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, the Chairman of the Village Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to sign the application for federal assistance, and any other official Project documents that are necessary to obtain such assistance, including any agreements, contracts or other documents that are required by the State of Nebraska or the Federal Highway Administration.

THAT, the Village currently has the written commitment for the 20% local matching share for the Project elements that are identified on the application form and the supplemental documents and will, as it becomes necessary, allocate the local funds for the Project.

THAT, the Village will commit the necessary financial resources to operate and maintain the completed Project in a safe and attractive manner for 25 years.

THAT, the Village will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color, age, religion, disability, sex or nation origin in the use of any property or facility that is acquired or developed pursuant to the Project proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and any of the regulations promulgated pursuant to such Act.

THAT, the Village will comply with all rules and regulations of the Recreational Trails Program, applicable Executive Orders and all state laws that govern the grant applicant during the performance of the Project.

THAT, the Village will comply with the Federal accessibility and use standards where they can be reasonably applied.
