**WHEREAS**, the Maintenance Department of the Village of Waterloo is in need of on-call personnel; and

**WHEREAS**, according to the Maintenance Supervisor, there are sufficient funds available in the Maintenance Department budget to pay for this employee; and

**WHEREAS**, the employee will be hired as an "at-will" full-time employee, with a 3 month initial probationary period, starting as of the date of hire; and

**WHEREAS**, this employee will report directly to the Maintenance Supervisor; and

**WHEREAS**, a current copy of the Village of Waterloo Employee Handbook will be given to this employee and he will be required to comply with all policies in the handbook; and

**WHEREAS**, this employee will be required to attend and pass all required training; and


**WHEREAS**, this employee will be required to submit to all background checks required for their position.



**ORDINANCE NO. 818**

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE WAGES AND DUTIES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO ENGAGED IN REPLACING AND UPDATING WATER METERS, APPOINTING SUCH EMPLOYEES, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Designated employees of the village shall be authorized, when directed by the village maintenance supervisor, to replace outdated water meters, install endpoints and add endpoints to existing smart water meters (together, the "Work"). The Work shall only include those water meters owned by the village.

Section 2. The employees engaged in the Work shall be paid at a rate of \$ 25.<sup>00</sup> per hour for the time spent performing the Work. The village maintenance supervisor shall be paid at a rate of \$ — per hour for performing the Work.

Section 3. The initial village employees designated to perform the Work shall be Adam Smith, Matt Richman, Kenton Ewing, Nathan Murphy and the village maintenance supervisor. Additional employees may be designated or removed by resolution.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect fifteen days from and after its passage.
