

**VILLAGE OF WATERLOO
RESOLUTION NO. 10-11-16-03**

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2016, the Village Board of the Village of Waterloo, Nebraska, assessed upon the several lots and parcels of land special assessments to pay the cost of constructing certain sidewalk improvements as set out in the schedule therein; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board desires to amend the date of delinquency from the 1st day of January for each and subsequent years to that of the 12th day of July in order to conform to Douglas County assessment dates.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERLOO, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

THAT, paragraph 5 in Village of Waterloo Resolution No. 07-12-16-03 is hereby amended to read:

“5. Said assessments for paving are payable in seven equal installments, the first of which shall become delinquent not less than fifty (50) days from the date of adoption of the resolution, and the remaining installments shall become delinquent on the 12th day of July + 1 subsequent to the date of levy and thereafter, in one, two, three, four, five and six years respectively; that each of said installments shall draw interest from the date of the passage of this resolution at the rate of four per centum (4%) per annum, until the same become delinquent, and after the same become delinquent interest at the rate specified by law for delinquent special assessments for such districts and projects shall be paid thereon; provided all said assessments may be paid at one time on any lot or land within fifty (50) days from the date of levy without interest.”
